

THIS JUDGEMENT IMPLEMENTATION COOPERATION ACCORD

CONCLUDED this.....day of.....2014

BETWEEN: THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA, hereinafter referred to as defendants, represented by first defendant in the suit on the one part;

AND: THE REPUBLIC OF AMBAZONIA, hereinafter referred to as the plaintiffs, represented by the second plaintiff in the suit on the other part;

WHEREBY IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS

Whereas the following Orders Nisi inter alia in suit **FHC/ABJ/CS/526/2013**, have become **Orders Absolute-**

1 A declaration that the Special Regime which illegally put the plaintiffs' Bakassi Peninsula under control of Cameroon, was null and void ab initio, on the grounds that it was created by the 12 June 2006 agreement concluded by signatories who lacked locus standi.

2 An order that the 1st defendant should cause all persons and logistics brought unto the Bakassi Peninsula under that Special Regime to be removed; and should deliver vacant possession of the said Peninsula to the plaintiffs.

3 An order that the 1st defendant should ensure that Cameroon withdraws without condition, to its territorial boundaries at its independence on **1 January 1960**, in compliance with the judgment of the International Court of Justice, in pursuance of which the United Nations obtained a commitment from the Cameroon President to comply saying "/President Paul Biya of the Republic of Cameroon in a bid to provide lasting peace to the Bakassi conflict hereby commit myself and my government to respect the territorial boundaries of my country as obtained at its independence

Whereas the process of implementing the judgment demands very close cooperation between the Defendants and the Plaintiffs which needs to be structured as a Judgment Implementation Technical Cooperation Accord.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY STIPULATED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1 A Nigeria-Ambazonia Judgment Implementation Technical Cooperation Accord is hereby created

Article 2 For the purpose of implementing the said judgement, either nation may request assistance from the other.

Article 3 Pending the final conclusion of the implementation process, a threat to the security or territorial integrity of the one nation shall be regarded as a threat to both
