Ambazonian Law Enforcement Task Force Ordinance.

I Fon Fongum Gorji-Dinka, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Ambazonian Constitution do make the following ordinance:

Citation: This ordinance may be cited as Ambazonian Law Enforcement Task Force Ordinance.

Article 1 There is hereby created an **Ambazonian Law Enforcement Task Force (ALETForce)**

Article 2 It shall consist of (i) the Prime Minister (ii) the Foreign Minister (iii) the Minister of Defense (iv) the Minister for Finance (v) the Secretary General at the Presidency (vi) the Chief Security Officer (vii) persons to be subsequently nominated

Article 3 Its duties shall be to conceive, plan, launch and complete the process of enforcing any law or judgment or legally enforceable text, domestic or international, which demands the withdrawal or expulsion of Cameroun from Ambazonia.

Article 4 The legal texts shall include (i) the United Republic of Cameroon [law 84/01](#) (ii) the Cameroon High Court judgment [HCB/28/92](#) (iii) the United Nations Human Rights Council judgment [ICCPR/1134/2002](#) (iv) United Nations Charter **Article 2 paragraph 4** (v) United Nations Charter **Article 51** (vi) the Nigerian Federal High Court judgment [FHC/ABJ/CS/526/2013](#) (vii) the Annan Bakassi Peace Accord (ABPA) of 31 January 2005

Article 5 A **Special Bailiff Force** (SBF) is hereby created.

Article 6 The recruitment, training, promotions and payment structure of the **Special Bailiff Force** shall be worked out by the Ambazonian Law Enforcement Task Force.
